Three Rivers Public Health Update

Three Rivers Public Health Department (3RPHD) is offering Booster Doses at all COVID-19 clinics. "We are thrilled with the amount of interest that we are having with Booster doses. 3RPHD is offering free COVID-19 booster doses for all eligible individuals booster doses at our COVID-19 walk-in clinics during the following days and times. Tuesdays: 3:00pm-6:30pm and Fridays: 12:00pm-3:30pm. Pharmacies and some medical providers are also providing Booster doses please reach out to them to learn more." said Terra Uhing, Executive Director of the Three Rivers Public Health Department.

Anyone who is 18 years and older and received the Johnson & Johnson (Janssen) vaccine should receive a booster of any of the three available vaccines after at least **two months** have passed since their initial dose.

As with <u>people vaccinated with the Pfizer vaccine</u>, those who received Moderna vaccine should get a booster dose, according to the CDC, if at least <u>six months</u> have passed since they completed their initial course of vaccination, and they are:

- 65 years and older
- Ages 18+ who live in long-term care settings
- Ages 18+ who have underlying medical conditions
- Ages 18+ who live or work in high-risk occupational settings

Sadly, we are announcing five new COVID-19 related deaths. This brings the total COVID-19 related deaths in our health district to 151.
