Three Rivers Public Health Department (3RPHD) is reporting that COVID-19 hospitalizations, and deaths are on the rise. "We are seeing that unvaccinated 30-year old's are filling up our hospitals as quickly as vaccinated 80-year old's. We know that the COVID-19 vaccinations are a tool to help prevent severe illness—so please consider getting vaccinated it you are not already." said Terra Uhing, Executive Director of the Three Rivers Public Health Department.

**Regarding COVID-19 booster doses**: Everyone ages 18 and older should get a booster shot either when they are <u>6 months after their initial Pfizer or Moderna</u> series or <u>2 months after their initial J&J vaccine</u>.

Sadly, we are announcing five new COVID-19 related deaths. This brings the total COVID-19 related deaths in our health district to 160.
